We have received proposals from four vendors - Dell, Hewlett-Packard, IBM and Apple. We will spend roughly the next four weeks or so carefully evaluating each proposal and conducting interviews with each vendor to determine exactly what each one is offering, and how each proposes to handle the challenges that the Power To Learn program presents. The proposals will be scored according to a point system, and it is possible that more than one finalist will be named. The last stage of the evaluation will be conducted by a committee of school district technology and instructional administrators, the superintendent, and a group of local business leaders the superintendent has invited to join the process. That committee will pick the winning proposal. At that point, probably early to mid-November, we will make the proposal public and begin gathering input from the community.
